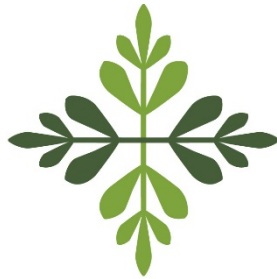

# Cuyahoga County Bike/Scooter Share Program

- Established licensing process and regulations for Bike/Scooter Share in Summer 2019
- Five vendors currently operate in Cleveland under this program:
  - Bird, Lime, Spin, Wheels, and HOPR
- Currently reviewing applicants for the 2021-2022 permit cycle, effective June 1, 2021 through May 31, 2022
- County's license requires that each vendor place a minimum of 150 bicycles and/or scooters outside of the City of Cleveland

# 2019 East Side Community Survey

- Joint survey with Cleveland Heights, University Heights, Euclid, and South Euclid from November 11 – December 31, 2019
- 1,178 responses (455 Shaker residents)
- 73.1% of respondents supportive of a bike/scooter share trial (64.6% for Shaker)
- Euclid and South Euclid have passed legislation and plan to participate in the County's program



# Timeline

- Legislation and County MOU must be passed by the end of May 2021 in order to participate in the 2021-2022 permit cycle
- Potential schedule:
  - March-April: draft legislation and internal review
  - May 7: Safety and Public Works Committee
  - May 24: City Council



# Discussion Points

- Should the mandatory helmet law apply to e-bike/e-scooter devices?
  - Not required by other communities
- Will riding on sidewalks be allowed and if so, where?
  - Cleveland: sidewalk riding is not permitted in commercial districts
  - Lakewood: sidewalk riding is not permitted
  - Euclid/South Euclid: sidewalk riding is permitted
- What should be the maximum speed for devices?
  - Cleveland's maximum speeds: 15mph for e-scooters and 20mph for e-bikes
- Is Shaker Heights prepared to participate in the bike/scooter share program at this time?
